For those who do aspire to being on the stage auditions are planned at St Faiths Church on Saturday 1st October, 11am – 2pm. If you can sing please bring along your favourite song on the day. The auditions will help to determine who is to play which part.

All you need to do to register your interest is either put your name in the book beside last year's photos at the back of church, or speak to Penny Mitchell.

Rehearsals will be at St Faith's Church, mostly on Sunday afternoons, 3pm – 5.30pm up until Christmas and then Sunday afternoons, 3pm – 5.30pm and Friday evenings, 7pm – 9pm up to the performance weekend.

Just for info though, the pantomime version of Aladdin (which is the original) is not the same as the Walt Disney and Cartoon versions that some may be familiar with.

It's the second most popular pantomime, after Cinderella and has been around for over 200 years though the script we are using was written in 1995 and includes all of the well known characters.
